## Components

Cleaning windows, cupboards, countertops Window Screens Sinks and bathtubs

### Timing & Prerequisites

- This phase of the project cannot begin until all the construction is complete.
- The House/Project Lead will work with the Construction Superintendent to coordinate these volunteer activities.

### **Materials Needed**

Natural Glass Cleaner Natural Floor Cleaner Natural General Surface Cleaner Goof-Off

Paper Towels
Cotton Rags

Magic Eraser Sponge

# **Phase Specific Tools Needed**

## **Description:**

- Swiffer Mop
- o Broom and Dust Pan
- o Vacuum Cleaner
- Razor Scraper
- Soft Bristle Brush
- Squeegee
- Garden Hose and Nozzle
- Putty Knife

#### **Seal Attic Accesses**

• After passing the "Occupancy Permit Inspection", reinstall the attic access covers and seal them closed with a bead of caulk.

### **Clean the Kitchen**

- Dust all cabinets and drawers inside and out.
- Clean the sink and counter tops, using Natural All-Purpose Surface cleaner and cotton rags.
- Place any warranty cards and owner's manuals in the kitchen drawer closest to the stove.

### **Clean the Vinyl Floors**

#### **Critical Issues**

- Do not use vacuums with any type of beater bar assembly on vinyl surfaces.
- ➤ Do not use vinegar, polishes, waxes, oil soaps, abrasive cleaners, harsh detergents, "mop and shine" products or solvents.
- Do not use rubber-backed mats.
- Do not expose flooring to direct sunlight for prolonged periods.
- > Do not use steam cleaners.
- Do not flood floor.
- Use walk-off mats at all outside entrances.
- Sweep, dust mop or vacuum.
- Lightly damp mop with a Neutral Floor Cleaner. Remove excess soil or scuffs by carefully scrubbing with a soft nylon brush or magic eraser sponge.
- Remove standing water and other liquids promptly, then follow with Neutral Floor Cleaner.

#### **Clean the Windows**

- Remove all stickers and glue from windows, using razor scraper and Goof Off adhesive remover.
- Clean the windows on both sides using Natural Window Cleaner and paper towels or squeegee.
- Open the windows and vacuum the space at the bottom.
- Install the window screens.

#### **Clean the Bathrooms**

- Clean the shower/bathtub, toilet and sink top using the Natural All-Purpose Surface cleaner and cotton rags.
- As you are cleaning the tub, check the surface very closely for any cracks or chips. These will need to be repaired.
- Dust the vanity.
- Clean the mirror using Natural Window Cleaner and paper towels. (Be sure all stickers and glue have been removed first).

• Sweep and mop the floor.

### **Clean Light Fixtures**

• Clean all light fixtures with a dry cotton rag.

### **Clean Porches**

- Sweep both porches and scrape up any mud, plaster, etc.
- Wash porches, steps and walk ways using a garden hose.
