Habitat for Humanity-MidOhio is pleased to present this snapshot of accomplishments during fiscal year 2022 (July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022).



Fiscal 2022 was a milestone year for Habitat MidOhio. We celebrated our 35th anniversary of partnering with central Ohio families and at the close of FY22, we have served a total of 416 families here and 430 via tithe to several African countries through homeownership, and 361 families in our service area by way of our home repair programs.

In March 2022, our affiliate received a \$6.75 million transformational gift from Mackenzie Scott as part of a larger gift to Habitat for Humanity International and 83 Habitat affiliates. We are humbled to receive this unexpected donation which will be used to further address the affordable housing shortage in central Ohio.

In FY22 we were glad to see the smiling faces of our faithful volunteers and partner families back out on site and ready to work!

Many exciting and new ventures are on the horizon as part of our new five-year strategic plan including creating a Community Development Financial Institution (CDFI) which will open many doors for the affiliate to serve more families who may not currently qualify for our programs.

Finally, we look forward to returning to a pre-pandemic milestone of serving over 100 families annually.
