# from our CEO & board chair

## 2024: Honoring the Past and Building the Future

Dear Friends and Supporters,

Fiscal Year 2024 served as a milestone year for our Affiliate as we said goodbye to E.J. Thomas after twenty years of service, welcomed a new President & CEO, and served our 1,000th family in Central Ohio. This year also underscored the importance of developing more housing, especially affordable housing in the region. Habitat for Humanity serves through a unique model of housing by connecting and partnering with public, private, nonprofit, faith, and academic groups; along with volunteers and families who want to buy their first house – to fund and build affordable homes.

Thanks to your generous support – whether through financial contributions, volunteer efforts, or donations to and purchases at our ReStores – 130 local families experienced the transformative power of safe, affordable housing. Together, we built 15 new homes, completed 114 home repairs, and rehabilitated one home, connecting people to hope and opportunity.

Looking ahead to Fiscal Year 2025, we are committed to continue our work in being a leader in solving the affordable housing crisis. Reports and studies from the Building Industry Association (BIA), Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC), the Affordable Housing Alliance of Central Ohio, the City of Columbus and others make it clear: we don't have enough housing to serve our current population, let alone the future, growing population. We will need your continued support to grow our ability to help people obtain and maintain their affordable housing.

We invite you to explore the 2024 Annual Report to learn more about how your partnership has helped create lasting change. I implore you to invite others to the journey of supporting affordable housing through Habitat for Humanity-MidOhio.

Thank you for being an essential part of this journey. We look forward to all that we will accomplish in the year ahead.

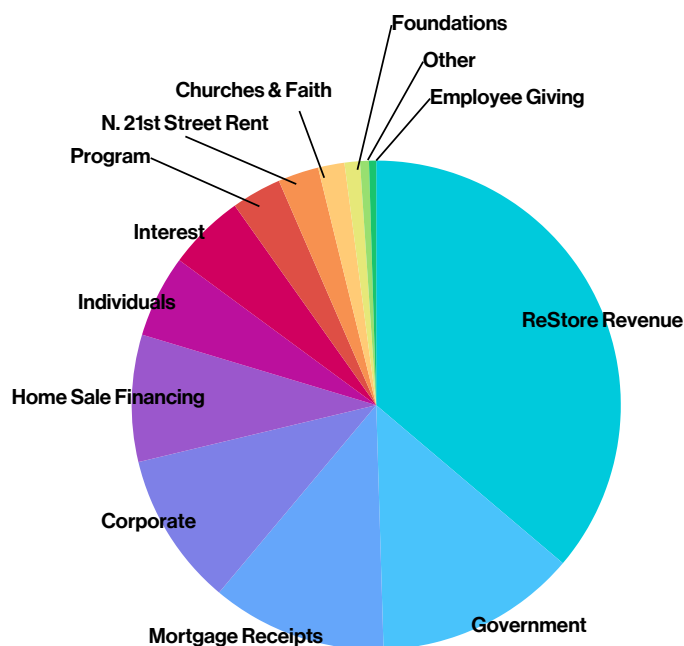

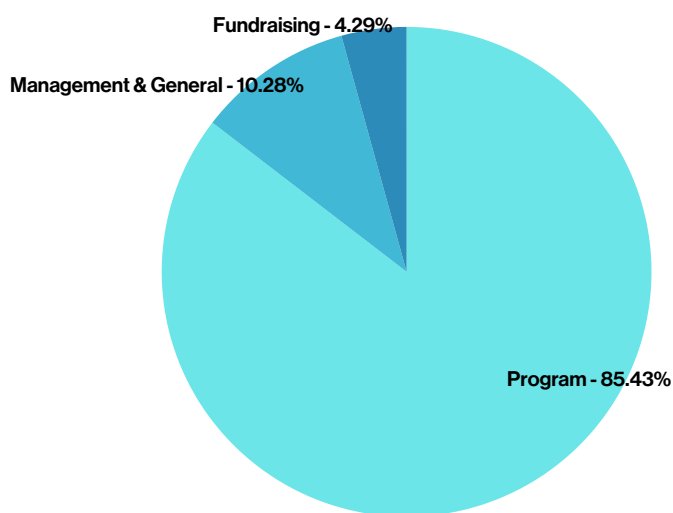

# homeownership program

creating strength, stability & independence



Homeownership provides families the strength, stability, and independence they need to build a better future for themselves and future generations.

Habitat MidOhio is one of the only housing agencies in Franklin, Licking, and Madison counties targeting first-time homebuyers who earn 30-60% of the area median income.

In Fiscal Year 2024, through our New Homeownership Program, we built 15 new homes, with an average HERS score of 58, providing energy efficient homes and cost-savings for new homeowners. Additionally, we rehabilitated one home, preserving valuable housing stock.

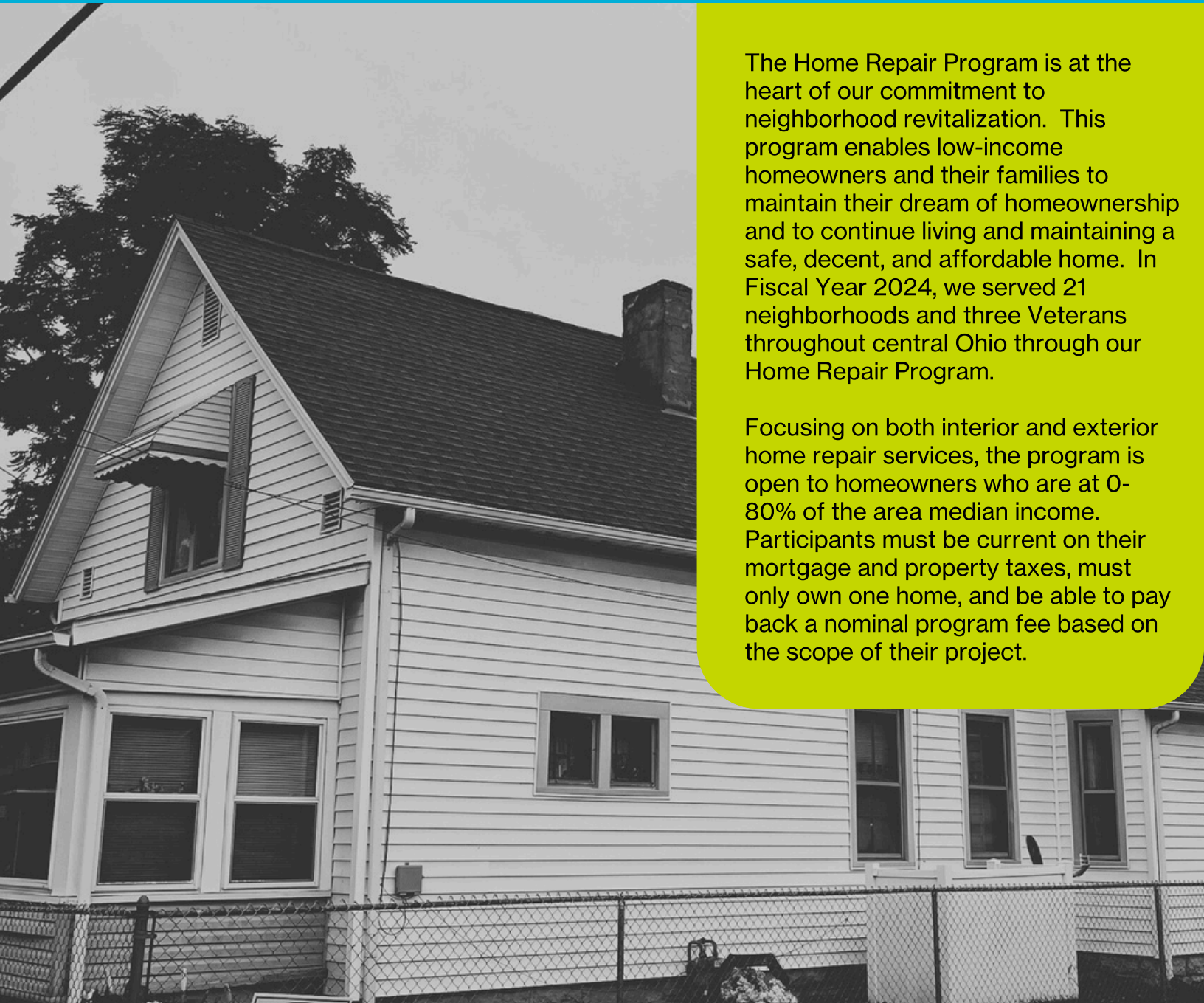

# home repair program

preserving the dream of homeownership



The Home Repair Program is at the heart of our commitment to neighborhood revitalization. This program enables low-income homeowners and their families to maintain their dream of homeownership and to continue living and maintaining a safe, decent, and affordable home. In Fiscal Year 2024, we served 21 neighborhoods and three Veterans throughout central Ohio through our Home Repair Program.

Focusing on both interior and exterior home repair services, the program is open to homeowners who are at 0-80% of the area median income. Participants must be current on their mortgage and property taxes, must only own one home, and be able to pay back a nominal program fee based on the scope of their project.

# MidOhio ReStores

your stuff. their dream. our mission.



Habitat MidOhio ReStores play an important role in the effort to combat the affordable housing crisis in central Ohio. Donations are sold to the general public and the proceeds help to offset most of Habitat MidOhio's administrative costs – so cash contributions go directly toward building homes and revitalizing communities.

In Fiscal Year 2024, we undertook a large project, working to sell off a sizeable amount of brand new store fixturing and building material. A prominent retailer went out of business prior to remodeling their stores and the inventory was turned over to our ReStores.

Additionally, in Fiscal Year 2024 we refreshed our Deconstruction Program and completed 12 deconstruction projects, resulting in \$21,000 of sales in salvageable materials in our ReStores.

# the playhouse project

little houses helping build big houses



The Playhouse Project is a unique opportunity that allows Habitat MidOhio to partner with sponsors to build a playhouse for a local family – providing children with a safe place to play and imagine what home means to them. Funds raised go toward supporting Habitat MidOhio's mission of inspiring hope, building homes, empowering families, and developing communities right here in central Ohio.

In Fiscal Year 2024, we hosted our 5th Annual Franklin County Blitz Build at Lower.com, building 22 playhouses over two days! We also hosted our largest Faith Blitz at One Church, building six playhouses.

Our Playhouse Project continued to expand with an increased number of sponsors hosting their own “mini blitzes” this year.
